  - a. One from a teacher
  - b. One from a member of the community
- 4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college or university
- 5. Must have demonstrated merit in community service /volunteerism
- 6. An official sealed high school transcript
- 7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
- 8. A completed Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

#### Perseverance:

- 1. Graduating senior.
- 2. GPA 2.0 or above
- 3. Two Letters of recommendation:
  - a. One from a teacher
  - b. One from a member of the community
- 4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college or university
- 5. Must have demonstrated overcoming hardship/adversity.
- 6. An official sealed high school transcript
- 7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
- 8. A completed Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Applicants may apply to each category, however, may only be awarded one scholarship.
